
# ACADEMIC MATTERS

The Class of 2025 enjoyed watching "The Den of Thieves" at Muvi Cinema, making it a great opportunity for them to relax and bond.


# Assembly / Cleanliness and Self-Hygiene

# **Upcoming Events and Activities**


Throughout our academic year, we are organizing a variety of activities. In February 2025, our learners will participate in the following events.
